Calhoun County Historical Commission 2021 Cemetery Report 12-16-21

The Calhoun County Historical Commission Cemetery Committee was limited in its work at the historic burial sites/cemeteries because of the continuing Corona Virus pandemic.

Mary Belle Meitzen continues to regularly monitor the historic cemeteries in Calhoun County. In September 2021, she also had new signs made for Ranger Cemetery because the old ones were worn and on the ground. In addition, the City of Port Lavaca removed the iron fence that bordered the front of Ranger Cemetery because of its poor condition. The fence has not been replaced at this time.

Earlier this year, the Calhoun County Historical Commission received two partial headstones that are believed to have originally come from Indianola Cemetery. The names on each are: Margaret Clement and David Vance. The commission decided that in 2022 the headstones would be repaired and returned to their original location.
